

Test Principle

The test principle applied in this kit is Sandwich enzyme immunoassay. The microtiter plate provided in this kit has been pre-coated with an antibody specific to Interleukin 1 Receptor Associated Kinase 3 (IRAK3). Standards or samples are then added to the appropriate microtiter plate wells with a biotin-conjugated antibody specific to Interleukin 1 Receptor Associated Kinase 3 (IRAK3). Next, Avidin conjugated to Horseradish Peroxidase (HRP) is added to each microplate well and incubated. After TMB substrate solution is added, only those wells that contain Interleukin 1 Receptor Associated Kinase 3 (IRAK3), biotin-conjugated antibody and enzyme-conjugated Avidin will exhibit a change in color. The enzyme-substrate reaction is terminated by the addition of sulphuric acid solution and the color change is measured spectrophotometrically at a wavelength of $450 \text{nm} \pm 10 \text{nm}$. The concentration of Interleukin 1 Receptor Associated Kinase 3 (IRAK3) in the samples is then determined by comparing the O.D. of the samples to the standard curve.
